On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes:

a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No.4822-543".

b. Change the Precautionary Labeling to read:

WARNING: Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco.

c. Add a 1-800 phone number to the First Aid section for medical treatment information.

- d. Based on the results of the Acute Oral Toxicity study, this product must be sold in Child Resistant packaging. Refer to the enclosed Acute Toxicity review for details. This comment also applies to 4822-51, 4822-167, 4822-119 and 4822-380 since these products relied on the same data.
- e. The marketing claims lined out in red on the enclosed stamped label are not acceptable and must be deleted.

4. Submit the One Year Storage Stability and Corrosion Characteristics studies once they are completed. It is recommended that observations be made at time intervals of 0,3,6,9, & 12 months. The Corrosion Characteristics study can be conducted simultaneously with the One Year Storage Stability study.

5. Product specific efficacy data will be required. Once the efficacy guidelines are in place, you will be notified of the efficacy requirements.

6. The product must be packaged in containers utilizing a concave trigger to help aim the product or other comparable mechanism that will ensure that the product will not be inadvertently sprayed in the eyes.


7. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

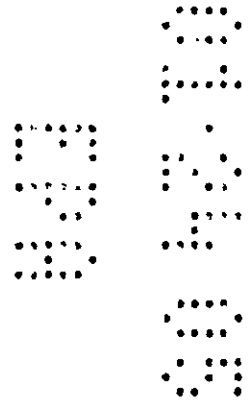

FIRST AID

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label.**

Hold container 6 to 8 inches from skin or clothing and spray with a slow sweeping motion. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, irritated or sunburned skin. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid over-application of this product. Frequent reapplication and saturation are unnecessary. Do not allow children to handle this product. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. **FOR MAXIMUM PROTECTION, spread evenly with hands to moisten all exposed skin.**

TO APPLY TO FACE: Spray palm of hand first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child.

WORKS ON CLOTHING TOO: Do not use under clothing. Spray shirts, pants, socks, and hats. For ticks and chiggers also spray cuffs, socks and around other openings in outer clothing. STORAGE: Store away from heat or flame in an area inaccessible to children.
