 - a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 4822-563"
 - b. Make the following label revision(s):

General Statement:

1. Delete all text throughout the label marked with "strikethrough."

Efficacy Review comment(s):

- 2. You should incorporate the following revisions as required by the efficacy review completed for this product. ¹
 - a. Delete the 1st optional marketing claim since it is a repetition of the revised 8th optional marketing claim.
 - b. The word "new" as listed in the 6th optional marketing claim is time-limited and can only be used for a time period not to exceed six (6) months following the date of registration for this product.
 - c. Revise the 8th optional marketing claim to read: "Kills German cockroaches on contact."
 - d. Delete the 11th optional marketing claim since it is an implied safety claim.
 - e. In the 13th optional marketing claim, insert the word "listed" immediately preceding the word "flying."
 - f. Delete the 16th and 17th optional marketing claims since they are vague and misleading.
 - g. In the 1st sentence of the 21st optional marketing claim, insert the words "of German cockroaches" immediately preceding the word "on." In the 2nd sentence, replace the word "insects" with the words "German cockroaches."

Directions for Use section comment(s):

- 3. Revise the subsection heading that reads "General Precautions and Restrictions" to read: "GENERAL PRECAUTIONS & USE RESTRICTIONS."
- 4. To facilitate inclusion of language from the REDs for pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide, you should add the following 2 additional use restrictions immediately preceding the 1st sentence in the paragraph at the top of page 2 of 5 as follows: "Apply this product only as specified on this label. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs."
- 5. Revise the section header "House Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Flying Moths:" to read: "House Flies and Flying Moths:" and replace the 2nd sentence of the paragraph following the section header with: "Keep room closed for at least 15 minutes and then thoroughly ventilate the treated area before reoccupying."
- 6. Revise the section header starting with "Ants, Cockroaches (Water Bugs/Palmetto Bugs), ..." to read: "Ants (excluding Fire, Pharaoh and Harvester Ants), Carpenter Ants, German Cockroaches, Sowbugs, Pillbugs, Crickets, Silverfish, Firebrats, Fleas, Brown Dog Ticks, Ticks (including ticks that may transmit Lyme disease) and Spiders (excluding Brown Recluse Spiders), including Black Widows:"
- 7. Revise the section header "Fleas and Ticks:" to read: "Fleas, Brown Dog Ticks and Ticks (including ticks that may transmit Lyme disease):" and replace the 1st sentence of the paragraph following this section header with: "Where fleas, Brown Dog ticks and ticks (including ticks that may transmit Lyme disease) are associated household pets, remove and launder or replace the pet's bedding, and spray the surrounding area."
- 8. Replace the 4th sentence of the paragraph following the section header "<u>For control of Ants, Aphids, ...</u>" which reads "Avoid over-saturating.," with "Do not wet plants to the point of run-off or drip."

9. To facilitate inclusion of language from PR Notice 2007-4, you should replace the text marked with "strikethrough" with: "Container Disposal: If empty: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available."

10. To facilitate inclusion of revised language from the acute toxicity review completed for this product, you should replace this section with: "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. To facilitate inclusion of language from the REDs for pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide and PR Notice 2008-1, you should replace this section with: "This product is toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. Drift and run-off may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. This product may contaminate water through run-off. This product has a potential for run-off for several weeks after application. Poorly draining soils and soils with shallow water tables are more prone to produce run-off that contains this product.

Johnson & Son, Inc. should note that a notice of availability of EPA's RED for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). In addition, EPA's RED for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins and/or piperonyl butoxide.

	General Precautions and Restrictions Shake well before using (Adjust spray nozzle to give a coarse, wet spray (Do not spray outdoors in heat of the day.)	/.)

Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried or until vapors and mists have dispersed, and the area has been thoroughly ventilated. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift. Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until vapors or mists have dispersed. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not wet plants to point of runoff or drip. Do not wet articles to point of runoff or drip. Do not use treated article until spray has dried. Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. Do not apply directly to or near water, storm drains, or drainage ditches. Do not apply when windy. To prevent product run-off, do not over water the treated areas or apply prior to heavy rainfall. INDOORS:

House Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Flying Moths: As a room spray to control these pests, close doors and windows and pump spray, aiming the nozzle into the upper corners of the room and filling the room with a fine mist. Keep room closed for at least 15 minutes and then air room out before occupancy. Before spraying in kitchen or dining areas, cover or remove food and utensils.

Ants, Cockroaches (Water Bugs/Palmetto Bugs), Sowbugs, Pillbugs, Crickets, Silverfish, Firebrats, Fleas, Ticks, and Spiders, including Black Widows and Scorpions: Spray into cracks and crevices, along baseboards, behind and beneath cabinets, cupboards, pantry, other food storage areas, under stoves, sinks, refrigerators, and in and around, waste containers and other areas where these pests are seen or suspected of hiding. Spray as many pests as possible, especially as they are being flushed from hiding. Spray ant trails and places where they are entering the house.

Fleas and Ticks: Where fleas and ticks are associated with household-pets, remove and launder of replace the pet's bedding, and spray the surrounding area. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices, along baseboards, carpeted areas, area rugs, and fabric covered furniture where these pests may be found. Replace pet bedding when spray is dry. Concurrent treatment of the pets and their yard areas is recommended with a product labeled for those sites and pests.

<u>Carpet Beetles</u>: Apply as a spot treatment along baseboards and edges of carpet and rugs. Also spray under carpets and area rugs after vacuuming area to remove debris. Spray carpet in corners of

rooms, under furniture, in closets, on shelving and other areas where these pests are seen or suspected.

Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Indian Meal Moths, Rice Weevils, Confused Flour Beetles: To kill the exposed forms of these pests, find and destroy infested packages of food products in cabinets and pantry. Remove shelf paper. Clean inside cabinets thoroughly. Remove packaged goods and spray shelves and cracks and crevices. Replace shelf paper with new paper and return packaged goods when spray is dry.

OUTDOORS

Vegetables (including in home greenhouses): Arrugula, Beets, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Carrots, Chinese Cabbage (Bok Choy), Chinese Mustard Cabbage (Gai Choy), Cabbage (Napa), Cauliflower, Cucumbers, Collards, Cilantro, Celery, Eggplant, Edible Gourds, Endive, Japanese Radish (Daikon), Lettuce (Head and Leafy), Okra, Melons (including hybrids – Cantaloupe, Casaba, Crenshaw, Honeydew, Muskmelon), Parsley, Parsnips, Potato, Peppers (including Bell, Chili, Cooking, Pimentos, Sweet), Pumpkins, Rhubarb, Rutabaga, Radishes, Swiss Chard, Squash (Winter and Summer), Spinach, Tomatillo, Tomatoes, Watermelons and Zucchini.

<u>Small Fruits and Berries</u>: Blackberries, Blueberries, Currants, Dewberries, Elderberries, Gooseberries, Grapes, Huckleberries, Olallie Berries, Raspberries (Black and Red), Strawberries and Youngberries.

<u>Fruits</u>: Apples, Apricots, Crabapples, Cherries (Sweet and Sour), Citrus Hybrids, Grapefruit, Loquat, Lemons, Limes, Nectarines, Oranges (Sweet and Sour), Oriental Pears, Pears, Pummelos, Peaches, Plums, Prunes, and Quince.

For Use on All Ornamental Plants: (such as Roses, Hyacinth, Gladiolus, Freesia). All Annuals (such as Cosmos, Celosia, Ageratum, Impatients). All Perennials (such as Gazania, Cineraria, Chrysanthemum, Zinnia). All Shrubs (such as Mountain Laurel, Juniper, Privet, Mock Orange). All Shade Trees (such as oak, London Plane, Maple, Sycamore, Mulberry). And All Vines (such as Trumpet Creeper, Creeping Lantana, Wisteria, Honeysuckle).

For Control of Ants, Aphids, Armyworms, Asparagus Beetles, Blister Beetles, Cabbage Loopers, 12-Spotted Cucumber Beetles, Colorado Potato Beetles, Corn Earworms, Crickets, Cross-striped cabbageworms, Diamondback Moth Larvae, Fireworms, Flea Beetles, Fruit Worms, Fruit Tree Leafrollers, Grape Leafhoppers, Gypsy Moths (larvae and adult), Harlequin Bugs, Tomato Hornworms, Imported Cabbageworms, Leafhoppers, Leafrollers, Leaftier, Mexican Bean Beetles, Potato Leafhoppers, Psyllids, Stink Bugs, Thrips, Vinegar Flies, and Webworms: Water plant thoroughly. Turn spray nozzle to the On position, and hold spray nozzle about 12" from the plants. Spray (lightly)(thoroughly) covering, contacting insects on upper and lower leaf surfaces until surfaces are slightly wet. Avoid over saturating. Spray when insects or their damage first appears. Do not wait until

plants are heavily infested. Spray may be applied up to and including day of harvest.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry, preferably locked storage area. Store in the original container in an upright position only. Store with spray nozzle securely closed. Do not store with spray nozzle below level of product in container. Nonrefillable container. Disposal: Do not reuse or refill this container. If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-529-3394 for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
