This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided:

- 1. You will submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
- 2. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
 - a) Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No.4822-564".
 - b) Remove the "First Aid Statement" by removing the directions for 'Skin'. Instead, add: 'Use of this product may cause reactions in rare cases." to the Precautionary Statements. under the heading 'Hazards to Humans'.
 - c) Based on the Flash Point and Flame Extension for this pressurized product, revise the Physical/Chemical Hazards Statement to read: "Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting."

- d) Revise the "Directions for Use" as follows:
 - i. Move "Apply sparingly around ears. When using on children, apply to your own hands first and then apply to the child." from the 'APPLY to FACE' paragraph to the paragraph before as they pertain to the general directions, especially those pertaining to children.
 - ii. Marketing Claims:
 - a. Remove: (Effective) DEET Alternative
 - b. Remove the general reference to 'Encephalitis'. You must make reference to a specific type of encephalitis.
- 3. Submit the results of a one-year storage stability (830.6317) and corrosion characteristics (830.6320) to the Agency on completion. It is recommended that the observations be made at 0,3,6,9, & 12 month intervals. The results must be submitted in a hard copy and an electronic format is also requested.
- 4. The basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated August 8, 2008 is acceptable and is the CSF of record. The alternate CSF #1 dated August 8, 2008 is also acceptable.
- 5. The primary eye irritation study (MRID 47518603) is acceptable and the toxicity category is classified as Category II in terms of eye irritation. The acute toxicity profile is as follows:
