On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

This product is unconditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) provided that you make the following label changes:

1. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

- a) Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No. 4822-581."
- b) Delete the marketing claims:
 - *No unpleasant odor*
 - *Keeps (prevents) you from approaching the nest*


The term odorless is a subjective term depending on who you ask and implied safety claims are not acceptable.

- c) Revise the statements under Directions for use/Outdoor Use to read as follows: "*Remove all exposed food and cooking utensils. Cover all food handling surfaces or wash thoroughly after treatment and before use. Do not use on edible crops...*"
- d) Revise "*bald-face hornets*" to read "*bald-faced hornets*."
- e) The following statements must be clearly distinguished from the First Aid Statements: "*Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment.*" Please refer to the boxed format example provided with PR Notice 2001-1.

2. The product chemistry data requirements for the 830 Series Subgroups A and B guidelines are satisfied.

- 3. The confidential statements of formula (CSF) for the basic and alternate formulations, both dated 04-04-2011 are acceptable.
- 4. The acute toxicity profile of the product has been determined to be as follows:
 - Acute Oral ----- IV Primary Eye Irritation ----- III
 - Acute Dermal --- IV Primary Dermal Irritation --- III
 - Acute Inhalation --- IV Skin Sensitization ----- Negative
- 5. Please submit two (2) copies of your revised labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR OUTDOOR USE:

Cover or remove all exposed food, dishes, utensils and food-handling surfaces or wash thoroughly after treatment and before use. Do not use on edible crops. Avoid spraying vegetation directly. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt.

To kill paper wasps, yellow jackets, mud daubers and bald-face hornets: For best results, spray in early morning or early evening when insect activity is minimal. Stand safe distance from nest and not directly underneath. Hold can as upright as possible while spraying. Point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Begin by spraying visible nest opening until insect activity has stopped. Continue spraying entire nest until thoroughly saturated to completely kill the nest population. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from heat, sparks, and open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

If empty: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where (steel) aerosol can recycling is available. Before offering for recycling, empty the container (can) by using the product according to the label. If recycling is not available, put in trash.

If partially filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 800-529-3394 for disposal instructions.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

CAUTION: Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

FIRST AID:
