DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow adults, children or pets to enter the treated area until spray has dried.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE. Hold container upright. Do no spray up into air. Apply to surfaces only. Point spray opening toward surface to be sprayed and press button firmly. Hold about 12" from surface being sprayed. Spray until surfaces are wet. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt, tile, rubber and plastic materials as staining may occur. To maintain control on plywood and vinyl surfaces re-treat weekly (every week).

ANTS: Apply to ant trails, also around doors, windows and wherever ants enter house.

ROACHES, WATERBUS, PALMETTO BUGS: Spray until wet in cracks around baseboards and other hiding places. When bugs are driven out, spray directly.

SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, SPIDERS, MULTI-COLORED ASIAN LADY BEETLES, CENTIPEDES, EARWIGS: Spray areas infested by these pests.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL:

Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!
