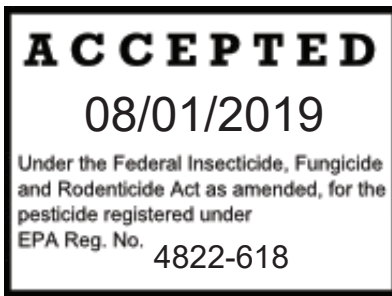

5. TO DISINFECT AND CLEAN: Allow to sit for at least 10 minutes.
6. Brush the entire bowl and flush.
7. Replace cap and close tightly until an audible click is heard
