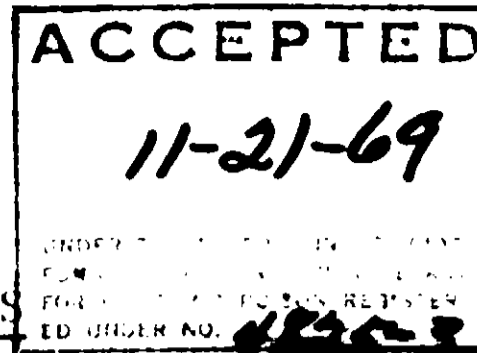

FOGGER FUEL KILLS FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS AND CERTAIN OTHER INSECTS

Insect Fogger Fuel Will Not Harm Shade Trees, Flowers, Shrubs, Grass When Used as Directed

FOGGER FUEL has been especially formulated for thermal foggers. It contains 3% Methoxychlor and 2.84% Lethane 384. Use only in Insect Foggers outdoors, around shade trees, flowers, shrubs, and grass to kill mosquitoes, flies, gnats and certain other small flying insects.

CAUTION

1. Avoid inhaling, or contact with the skin. Repeated or prolonged contact with the skin can cause toxic symptoms. After use and in case of spillage, wash with soap and water.
2. Harmful if swallowed.
3. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not use in dwellings.
4. Use with care. Toxic to fish. Keep out of any body of water. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
5. When fogging shade trees, flowers, shrubs, and grass, avoid use around vegetable gardens, fruit trees, or other food crop areas.

1. Formulated especially for thermal foggers. Do not dilute - use as it comes from the can.
2. Fill fogger with Fogger Fuel as directed by manufacturer. Shut off engine or unplug electric foggers while filling.
3. Start engine or electric fogger and allow to warm up as directed.
4. Open fuel adjusting valve until maximum dry fog is produced.
5. Apply fog at a rate of approximately 15 ounces of Fogger Fuel over an area of 5,000 square feet. For instance, for each 250 lineal feet of application, permit fog to penetrate to an effective depth of 20 feet. Best results can usually be obtained in the evening when the wind velocity is less than five m. p. h.
6. Direct fog into foliage, trees, under eaves and into other openings which harbor insects. When fogging, stay at least four feet away from trees, flowers, and shrubs.
7. CAUTION: Combustible mixture. If engine stops for any reason, shut off valve immediately. A fire could result if Fogger Fuel is allowed to accumulate in the muffler of a hot engine which is not running.
