


## for Dandelions and Broadleaf Weeds

### DIRECTIONS:

Apply to actively growing dandelions, plantain, chickweed, clover and other broadleaf weeds in lawns. Do not use during or just before rain. DO NOT reuse vial - DESTROY WHEN EMPTY.



1. Remove cap—fill KANE with water.
2. Drop 1 KARTRIDGE into KANE—replace cap.
3. Mix gently until KARTRIDGE dissolves.
4. Adjust nozzle for proper spray size.
5. Put KANE tip on weed, push down and release quickly, wetting weed thoroughly.
6. Complete kill of broadleaf weeds in 1 to 2 weeks.
7. Rinse KANE out after using.

### OTHER USES:

1. Spot Weed-it or other trigger sprayers use 1 tablet per 16 ounces

1. Remove cap-fill KANE with water.
2. Drop 1 KARTRIDGE into KANE-replace cap
3. Mix gently until KARTRIDGE dissolves.
4. Adjust nozzle for proper spray size.
5. Put KANE tip on weed, push down and release quickly, wetting weeds thoroughly.
6. After using, rinse KANE with water
7. Requires 1 to 2 weeks for complete kill
