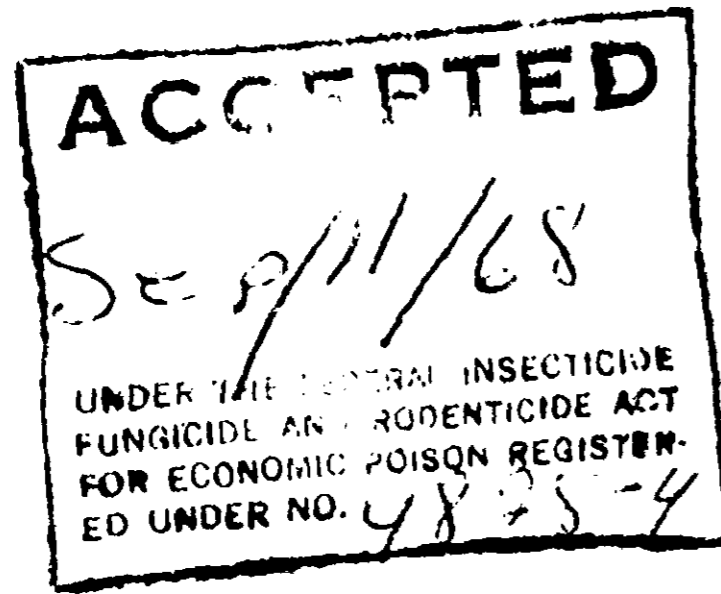

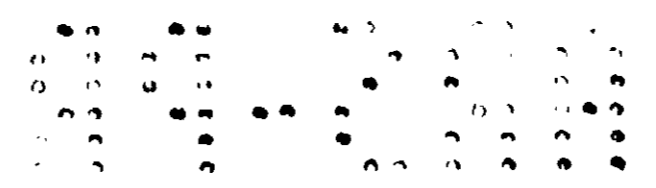

USE DILUTIONS

Average Everyday Cleaning:

From 10 to 14 ounces per gallon of hot water may be necessary to give good results. Allow solution to remain on surface for at least five minutes to dissolve excessive buildup of wax. It is not necessary to rinse. Merely pick up solution with a dry clean mop.
