DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Municipal - Professional Control
Some areas of use:

Garbage dumps, city dumps, out houses, porches, building interiors, alleyways, outside areas, unoccupied buildings, fly and mosquito breeding areas.

FLY CONTROL - OUTSIDE AREAS:

Mix 1 part I. O. 50 with 8½ parts of kerosene and apply on outside surfaces and resting places, but not on vegetation.

FLY CONTROL - INSIDE AREAS:

Mix 1 part I. O. 50 with 8½ parts of solvent, such as kerosene or No. 2 diesel oil. Spray around windows, doors, ledges and along baseboards. Thoroughly wet all surfaces.

COCKROACH CONTROL - INSIDE AREAS:

Mix 1 part I. O. 50 with 8½ parts of solvent such as kerosene or No. 2 diesel oil. Apply as a coarse spray or brush onto surfaces such as in cracks, baseboards, behind sinks, etc.

MOSQUITO CONTROL - OUTSIDE AREAS:

Mix 1 part I. O. 50 with 8½ parts of kerosene and spray with sprayer, fogger or smoke generator. Spray at a rate of 2 quarts per acre. Do not apply directly to foliage.

NOTE:

LARVICIDE CONTROL:

Mix 1 part of I. O. 50 to 22½ gallons kerosene or No. 2 diesel oil. Apply this mixture at a rate of ½ to 1 measuring cup per 1,000 square feet of water surface. Use only in intermittently flooded areas, standing water, temporary rain ponds, sloughs and log ponds.

Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

CAUTION

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues. Protective information may be obtained from your cooperative agricultural extension service.


