Dimethyl amine Salt of 2,2-methyl-4-chloro-phenoxypropionic acid

Dimethyl amine Salt of 2,4-dichlorophenoxypropionic acid

WKS-74 is a very broadleaf weed in lawns with an affinity to desirable grasses. WKS-74 wherever 2, 4-D is recommended, including Bermuda, Mission, and Kentucky bluegrasses - also fescues and ryegrasses.

NOTE: Use also WKS-74M preferably to WKS-74 to eradicate weeds in bent-grasses.

WEEDS CONTROLLED

Buckhorn, Clover, Common Chickweed, Curled Dock, Dandelion, English Daisies, Ground Ivy, Knotweed, Lamb's Quarters, Mallow, Monarda, Chickweed, Morning Glory, Pigweed, Plantain, Purslane, Ragweed, Red Clover, Red Sorrel, Stachys, Spewwort, White Clover, Wild Garlic, Wild Onion, Yarrow.

NOTE: WKS-74 is slower acting than 2, 4-D; therefore some weeds will be controlled before others. Complete weed control should occur in 3 to 4 weeks.

USE DIRECTIONS

Mix with water. Use 2-4 gallons water per 1000 sq ft (20-40 gallons per acre). Apply from 4 fluid oz per 1000 sq feet (3 1/2 quarts per acre) to 5 fluid oz per 1000 sq ft (6 quarts per acre).

Repeat application if necessary. Apply in spring or fall when weeds are actively growing. Knotweed is more easily controlled in spring or early summer when weeds are young.

PRECAUTION: Do not apply during very hot weather or when turf is suffering from dry conditions as damage to grass may result.

Do not mow grass before or after application several days. Do not water for 24 hours after application of WKS-74.

Do not apply during heavy rainfall periods. Do not use on newly seeded areas. Do not use WKS-74 if you want clover in your turf or lawn area. Do not use on turf where dichondra, bentgrasses such as buffalo carpet and St. Augustine predominate as they may be injured.

We suggest fertilizing before or after application to encourage healing of the lawn to fill in the bare areas where the weeds have died. Reseed the bare spots 2 to 4 weeks after application and after weeds have been removed.

CAUTION

Keep Out of Reach of Children

After mowing or watering, application of WKS-74 should be made on a lawn or garden area that has been mowed and watered. Do not use on lawns or gardens that have been mowed and watered.
