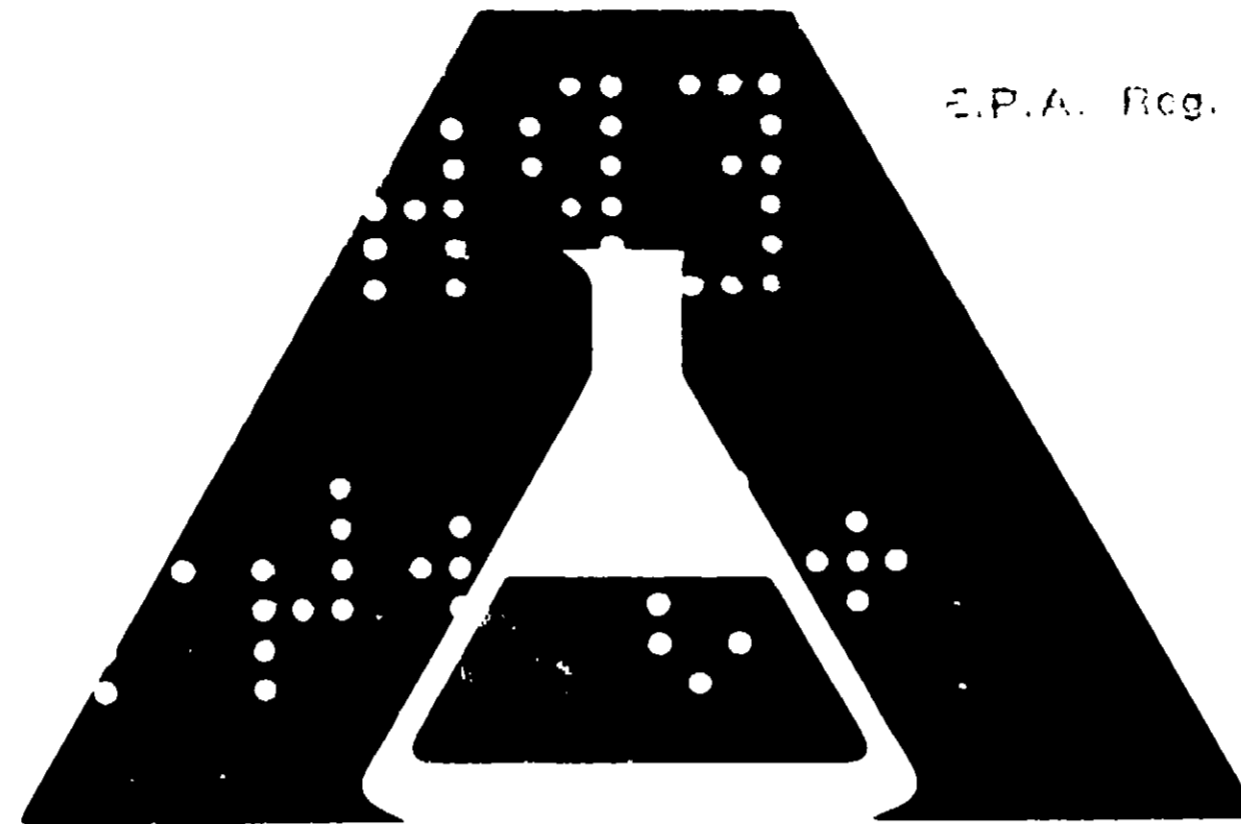

DIS-SAN

DETERGENT - DISINFECTANT - DEODORANT - SANITIZER

1. General Disinfection of sickrooms, utensils, locker rooms, kennels, shower rooms. Heavy soil deposits and gross buildup of organic waste must be removed from surfaces before application of the disinfecting solution. Use 1.5 ounce per gallon of water. A pump dispenser or a standard graduated measuring cup may be used to measure the quantity of product needed.

2. Disinfection of personal belongings such as brushes, combs, scissors, razors. Soak for approximately 10 minutes in a solution of 2½ ounces per gallon of water.

3. Sanitizing - For kitchen tables, refrigerators, garbage cans, and dispensers previously cleaned, use 2 ounces of DIS-SAN per 2½ gallons of water.

4. To disinfect athlete's foot fungi on all floors including locker rooms and shower rooms, use 2 ounces of DIS-SAN per gallon of water and scrub suspected areas thoroughly.

5. Deodorant - 1 to 1½ ounces of DIS-SAN per gallon of water for use in refrigerators, bathrooms, sick rooms, garbage cans.

6. Deodorant - to deodorize and remove vomit stains, food stains on rugs, blankets, bedclothes. Wash and rinse with a solution of 1 ounce per gallon of water.

For General Cleaning

1. For general detergent and cleaning of walls, floors, refrigerators, bathrooms, use 2 ounces per gallon of water.

2. For spot cleaning of floors and rugs, use 4 ounces per gallon of water.

3. For Rug Shampooing and Deodorizing - use 4 ounces of DIS-SAN per gallon of water. Work up lather and apply with a sponge. Be careful not to overwet the rug. Vacuum or dry up thoroughly.

4. Wax Removal - depending on the amount of wax buildup and conditions, use a solution of from 6 ounces to 15 ounces per gallon of very hot water.

NOTE: A terminal potable water rinse of treated food contact surfaces must be made before reuse.

DANGER

KEEP OUT of REACH of CHILDREN

Corrosive. Causes severe eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

First Aid: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

Note To Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
