An excellent disinfectant for use in Hospitals, Hotels, Motels, Schools, Industrial Plants and Municipal Buildings. Make a solution of 3 oz. of Disinfectant per each gallon of water. Apply with a mop or rag on floor surfaces, walls and woodwork.

As a deodorant spray, use 4 oz. of Disinfectant per each gallon of water.

Athlete's foot fungus control on Environmental Surfaces: Use a dilution of 2 oz. of Disinfectant per gallon of water. Scrub shower stall floors, rubber and plastic bath mats, locker room floors, benches and all surfaces contacted by the bare feet each day.
