POWDERY MILDEW on CHRYSANTHEMUMS, CALENDULA, DAHLIAS, PHLOX, SWEET PEAS, DELPHINIUMS, LILACS, BEANS, PEAS, PEACHES

EVST on CHRYSANTHEMUMS, SNAP DRAGONS (before or after blossoming), CARNATIONS, ASPARAGUS and BEANS

COMMON RED SPIDER, PACIFIC MITE on BEANS, COTTON, EVERGREENS, FIGS, PEAS, PLUMS

THRIPS, CITRUS RED SPIDER and TWO SPOTTED MITE on CITRUS FRUITS

Apply early in the morning or cool of the evening when the air is still. Thoroughly cover all stems, leaves and blossoms on both upper and lower surfaces. CHIGGER CONTROL

Control chiggers in the yard by dusting over the entire lawn, flower garden, shrubs and any place the chiggers may be hiding at weekly intervals or a day or two before protection is desired. The contents of this container will cover from 750 to 1,000 square feet.
