INITIAL CHLORINATION: For new pools, spring start-up or superchlorination, add 1 oz. of Clor-Aid Granules per 1,000 gallons of pool water to yield 5-10 ppm available chlorine. After 1 hour, use a Coastal Test Kit to determine the chlorine residual. If below i.0 ppm (parts per million), repeat dosage until 1-3 ppm is obtained.
