### Use a Coastal Measure Aid, or a Clean, Dry Spoon or Scoop Made of Metal, Ceramic, Plastic or Glass.

For freshly filled pools, use 4 Tablets per 1000 gallons of water daily (6 Tablets weigh approximately 1 oz.). When completely dissolved, Tablets provide recommended chlorine residual. Repeat dosage as needed to maintain a chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. During extreme heat or with heavy bather load, add proper number of Tablets every 2 hours. Place proper number of Clor Aid Tablets in dispenser sold for this purpose and immerse below water surface. Test water frequently using Coastal Test Kit (available at your dealer) to insure required chlorine content of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. A ph range of pool water between 7.2 to 7.8 should be maintained.

Because this content contains over 10% available chlorine, we must (by law) label it "Poison". Recommended solutions are not classified as poisonous.

**Precautions:** Irritating to skin and lungs. Causes eye damage. Strong Oxidizing Agent.

Contact with heat, friction, moisture, foreign materials,\* or contamination from any source, may result in fire. Never mix with other materials. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes or on skin.
