PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides, or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

 Use in public rooms, homes, restaurants, barber and beauty shops and pet animal quarters for disinfecting floors, walls, tables, counter tops and other porcelain enamel, tile, plastic or vinyl surfaces or furnishings

FOR DISINFECTION

1. Flush away surface soils with water where possible.
2. Clean with a solution of 5 ounces of DISINFECTANT per gallon of water.
3. Rinse with clear water.
4. Apply disinfecting solution so as to thoroughly wet all surfaces. For non-porous, easily cleaned areas, make a disinfecting solution of 5 ounces of DISINFECTANT per gallon of water. For porous surfaces, areas difficult to clean, or contagious disease areas, make a disinfecting solution using 8 ounces of DISINFECTANT per gallon of water. Surfaces directly contacting food must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

FOR DEODORIZING
 For garbage cans and similar refuse areas, use a solution of 16 ounces per gallon of water. Spray or wet all surfaces.

CHEMICAL PROPERTIES

AL-GE-GO is an outstanding algae growth depressant in all types and sizes of pools. Helps eliminate and prevent odors from confined water.

AL-GE-GO is fully compatible with alkalizing and flocculating agents normally used in swimming pools, and is relatively non-corrosive to rubber and metals. Works most effectively at pH levels over 7.0. Highly concentrated.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Algae and slime may be effectively controlled with 1 gallon of AL-GE-GO per 47,500 gallons of water every 3 days. In hot, sunny weather, this dosage should be given every 2 days. Contents should be added to the pool at various points, or added through the filters. Each time the system is drained and refilled, repeat the initial dose. For small pools, use 1 pint to 6,000 gallons of water, or one cup to 3,000 gallons. To sanitize walls, runways, locker rooms, and other areas surrounding swimming pool, use a solution of 2 ounces of AL-GE-GO to 4 gallons of water.

If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
