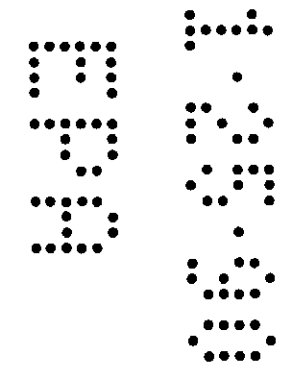

CHEMICAL PROPERTIES

Coastal Pool Aid Liquid is a conditioning agent for keeping wading and swim pool water sparkling clear and sweet, working effectively to control algae growth and odor. This product combines, in a single operation, the necessary chemicals to treat and maintain pools free of visible algae. Coastal Pool Aid Liquid is relatively non-corrosive to rubber and metals and may be used with all types of equipment at the treatment levels below. Coastal Pool Aid Liquid is an outstanding algae growth depressant.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Water clarity may be maintained and algae and slime effectively controlled with two cupfuls of Pool Aid Liquid per 2,500 gallons of water. This represents an initial treatment after the usual cleaning operation. For follow-up treatment, use only one cupful per 2,500 gallons of water every four days, and in hot sunny weather or with heavy bather load, every two days.

FOR OTHER SIZE POOLS, USE PROPORTIONATE AMOUNTS.

To sanitize walls, runways, locker rooms and other areas surrounding swim pool, use a solution of 2 oz. of Coastal Pool Aid Liquid to four gallons of water.
