

Algae and slime may be effectively controlled with one gallon of COASTAL ALGI-KARE per 30,000 gallons of water. This is an initial treatment after the usual cleaning operation. For subsequent treatments, use one quart of COASTAL ALGI-KARE for each 30,000 gallons of water every four days. In hot, sunny weather, this dosage should be used every two days.

ALGI-KARE should be placed in the pool at various points or added through the filters. Each time the system is drained and refilled, repeat initial dose. For small pools use one pint to 3,000 gallons of water or one cup to 1,500 gallons. One cubic foot is about 7 1/2 gallons.

To sanitize walls, runways, locker rooms and other areas surrounding swimming pool, use a solution of two ounces of COASTAL ALGI-KARE to four gallons of water.
