DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Algae and slime may be effectively controlled with one gallon of Algi Kare per 30,000 gallons of water. This is an initial treatment after the usual cleaning operation. For subsequent treatments, use only one quart of Algi Kare for each 30,000 gallons of water every four days. One cubic foot is about 7-1/2 gallons. In hot, sunny weather, this dosage should be used every two days. Algi Kare should be placed in the pool at various points or added through the filters. Each time the system is drained and refilled, repeat initial dose. For small pools use one pint to 3,500 gallons of water or one cup to 1,500 gallons. One cubic foot is about 7-1/2 gallons. To sanitize walls, runways, locker rooms and other areas surrounding swimming pool, use a solution of two ounces of Algi Kare to four gallons of water.

CHEMICAL PROPERTIES

Algi Kare is an outstanding algae growth depressant in all types and sizes of pools. Helps eliminate and prevent odors from confined water. Algi Kare is fully compatible with alkalizing and flocculating agents normally used in swimming pools and is relatively non-corrosive to rubber and metals. It may be used with all types of equipment. Works most effectively at pH levels over 7.0. Highly concentrated.

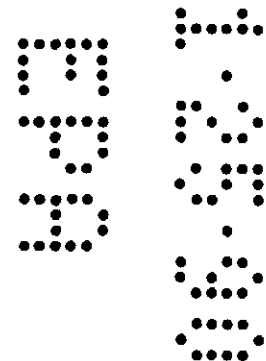
