DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits, then thoroughly wet surfaces as recommended and required.

Mix one part disinfectant with 9 parts of water. Use softened water, and apply with a clean, detergent free, soap free, brush or cloth. Allow 10 minutes contact time in a single application. The recommended use solution is prepared fresh for each use and then discarded.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
