



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For initial dose in clean or freshly filled pools, add 1 packet (2 oz.) per 200 gallons of pool water. Then add ½ packet (1 oz.) per 200 gallons of pool water every 4 days under normal circumstances, and every 2 days in hot, sunny weather. To sanitize wading pool walls and other areas use a solution of two ounces (1 packet) of Pool Aid Powder to one gallon of water. Apply this use solution to wading pool walls and all other pool side surfaces with brush, rag or mop. Thoroughly wet all surfaces after the pool has been drained.

For Rectangular Pools Length x Width x Average Depth* x 7.5 = Capacity in Gallons. For Round Pools - Diameter x Diameter x Average Depth* x 5.9 = Capacity in Gallons. * If in amount of feet.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For fully filled pools, add 1 packet (2 oz.) per 200 gallons of pool water every 4 days under normal conditions. In hot, sunny weather, add 1 packet (2 oz.) per 200 gallons of pool water every 4 days under normal conditions. To sanitize wading pool walls and pool surfaces, add 1 ounce (1 packet) of Pool Aid Powder to one gallon of water. Apply to wading pool walls and all other pool side surfaces with a brush. Rinse surfaces after the pool has been drained.
