FOR CONTROL OF FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS AND ADULT MOTHS in homes, food establishments, farm buildings and warehouses; Close all windows and stop all ventilators. Direct fine mist or fog upward toward the center of the room and around the sides until the area is filled with fog or mist particles. Keep area closed for 10 to 15 minutes Clean up and destroy fallen insects.
