While filter pump is running, add 1 gallon Winter Aid for up to 30,000 gallons of pool water. After 1 hr., shut off pump, and disconnect filters, chlorinators, etc. Cover pool to keep out air-borne matter. In the spring, reconnect equipment and add chemicals as normally required.

2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.


