

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is intended to be used only to help control, by bacteriostatic and algaestatic action, swimming pool odors and algae over the winter months. Each tablet weighs 5-3/4 oz. Each application of four tablets, (total of 1 lb.-7 ounces), will treat 7,650 gallons of pool water during winter months. Remove all debris from pool by skimming surface, running filter and vacuuming foreign particles from the pool bottom. Drain any water from filter and pool piping to prevent freezing. Disconnect all electrical outlets. Remove dispensers from plastic bags. Remove tablets from plastic bag and place them in the dispenser baskets. Replacing the cover will secure the tablets in the baskets. Drop baskets into water toward the CENTER of the pool.

DANGER: Corrosive. May cause burns or eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. May be fatal or harmful if swallowed.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Note to Physician: Probably mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.

This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
