DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is intended to be used only to help control, by bacteriostatic and algaestatic actions, swimming pool odors and algae over the winter months. Each tablet weighs 4.6 oz. Each application of five tablets (total of 1 lb. 7 oz. - 652 grams) will treat 7,650 gallons of pool water during the winter months. Remove all debris from pool by skimming surface, running the filter and vacuuming foreign particles from the pool bottom. Drain any water from filter and pool piping to prevent freezing. Disconnect all electrical outlets. Remove dispenser from plastic bag. Drop basket towards the CENTER of the pool.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, promptly drink large quantities of milk, egg whites, or gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call physician immediately.

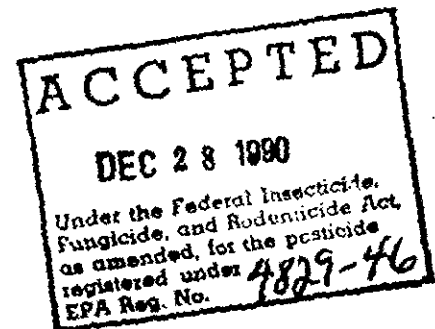
