The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided you:

1. Make the changes below before releasing the products for shipment bearing amended labeling:
 - a. The correct signal word for EPA Registration No. 4829-30 is "DANGER" based on the pH of the formulation. Add the following precautionary text for this product under Hazards to Humans:

DANGER. Corrosive. Causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or safety glasses and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. May cause skin sensitization in certain individuals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

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Modify first aid for swallowing as follows:

Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.

Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate use of gastric lavage.

Also, first aid for both eyes and skin should direct the user to get medical attention.

b. For EPA Registration No. 4829-48 reinstate "WARNING" on the upper panel.

2. Submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling incorporating the changes above.

A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.

We note that in our letter of September 24, 1986 we improperly directed you to add the ingredient substatement "from copper citrate complex" for EPA Registration No. 4829-28. Since there is no copper complex present in the product as marketed, it would be more correct to state "from copper sulfate pentahydrate." Please make this change on your next printing of labeling.

The updated formulas are acceptable and have been incorporated into our files. It is understood that the formulas dated September 8, 1986 replace previously accepted formulas for these products. We are also accepting the revised product names referred to above for EPA Registration Nos. 4829-28 and 4829-30.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is intended to be used only to help control by algacidal action swimming pool odors and algae over the winter months. Each tablet weighs approximately 5% oz. Each application of four tablets (total of 1 pound) content will treat 7,500 gallons of pool water during the winter months. Remove all debris from pool by skimming surface, running filter and vacuuming foreign particles from pool bottom. Drain any water from filter and pool piping to prevent freezing. Disconnect all electrical outlets. Remove dispenser from plastic bag. Drop basket into water toward the CENTER of the pool.
