



**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Algae and algal slime may be effectively controlled with initial dose of one gallon of Algacide Liquid per 25,000 gallons of water. Visible algae growth will require vacuuming to remove algae debris. If visible algae is still present or re-appears, repeat initial dose. For subsequent treatments, use one quart of Algacide Liquid for each 25,000 gallons every 5 days. For initial treatment of small pools, use one pint to 3000 gallons of water or one cup to 1500 gallons. Algacide Liquid should be placed in the pool at various points or added through the filter. Each time the pool is drained and refilled, repeat initial dose. Add one quart Algacide Liquid for each 5,000 gallons of make up water.

To sanitize walls, locker rooms, and other areas surrounding swimming pool, use solution of 2 oz Algacide Liquid to 2 1/2 gallons of water. Apply with mop, sponge, or cloth.

**CHEMICAL PROPERTIES**

Coastal Algacide Liquid is an outstanding algae growth depressant in all types and sizes of pools. Helps eliminate and prevent odors from confined water. Coastal Algacide Liquid is fully compatible with alkalizing and flocculating agents normally used in swimming pools and is relatively non-corrosive to rubber and metals. It may be used with all types of equipment. Works most effectively at pH levels over 7.0. Highly concentrated. This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters. Apply this product only as specified on label. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

**DANGER:** KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage; may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
