DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Non-Foaming Algaecide for Hot Tubs and Spas is used to control the growth of algae in exterior hot tubs and spas. For maximum effectiveness, spas and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Non-Foaming Algaecide for Hot Tubs and Spas.

Spas or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 10 to 15 fluid ounces of Non-Foaming Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa or hot tub, add initially 7 to 10 fluid ounces of Non-Foaming Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 to 5 fluid ounces of Non-Foaming Algaecide should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

## STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

## FIRST AID:

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get immediate medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

IF SWALLOWED: Promptly drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call physician immediately.

## ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the E.P.A.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
