

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
Recommended for spas and hot tubs operating at temperatures between 90°-105°F.

START UP

When starting up a reopened or freshly filled hot tub or spa, make sure the filtration system is clean and operating properly. Then adjust and maintain the pH in the range of 7.2-7.6, using Coastal pH Minus or pH Plus as indicated by the Coastal Test Kit for Hot Tubs and Spas. Adjust and maintain total alkalinity at 80-100 ppm, based on the Test Kit results and on the label directions for Coastal Total Alkalinity Plus and pH Minus. Superchlorinate by adding 1 or 2 tablets Stabilized Chlorinating Concentrate Tablets per 500 gallons. Repeat this step if necessary to establish a positive free chlorine residual of 1.0-2.0 ppm.

DAILY

Add Stabilized Chlorinating Concentrate Tablets prior to each use as needed based on testing with the Coastal Test Kit to maintain a free chlorine residual of 1.0-2.0 ppm. A suggested dosage of 1/2 oz. per 500 gallons provides this residual and should be added as indicated by daily tests for chlorine residual. The dosage required to maintain 1.0-2.0 ppm free chlorine residual may vary due to unusual conditions, such as high bather loads. Therefore, frequent use of the Coastal Test Kit is recommended. Using the Test Kit as a guide, maintain the pH within the 7.2-7.6 range and total alkalinity at 80-100 ppm. In general, 1/2 oz. of Stabilized Chlorinating Concentrate Tablets per 500 gallons of water will raise the chlorine residual by 1.0 ppm. After daily use has ceased, add 1 or 2 Stabilized Chlorinating Concentrate Tablets per 500 gallons. This should be performed with circulating system operating and aeration shut off.

SUPERCHLORINATION

Use 2 Stabilized Chlorinating Concentrate Tablets per 500 gallons either after each use, algae appears, chlorine odors are noted or high bather loads occur. Repeat if necessary to establish a positive free chlorine residual. Do not use hot tub or spa until the chlorine residual has dropped to 3 ppm.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID If swallowed, feed bread soaked in milk followed by olive oil. Call a physician immediately.

IF ON SKIN Flush off excess chemical and flush skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance, contact the regional office of EPA.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT. Use clean dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use might cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with organic matter or other chemical, may start a chemical reaction with generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reuse container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in the container for disposal and then bury or bury in a safe place.
