In the statement of Practical Treatment on both labels, delete the words, "drink large quantities of milk, egg whites, or gelatin solution, or if these are not available."

Algon 60 is compatible with chlorinating products and other chemicals used to treat pools and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Algon 60 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorinating products.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Algon 60 is used to control the growth of algae. For maximum effectiveness, heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to use of Algon 60.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 11 to 17 fluid ounces of Algon 60 per 10,000 gallons of water. Remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add an initial dose of 6 to 11 fluid ounces of Algon 60 per 10,000 gallons of water.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of Algon 60 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.
