2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. The entire product name declared in your letter dated October 26, 1984, "Coastal Concentrate 50" must be consistently declared throughout the label text. Abbreviated variations are not acceptable.
 - b. For the label size submitted, the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL heading and the Child Hazard Warning "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" would require a 12 point type size minimum and the signal word DANGER (front panel only) would require an 18 point type size minimum.



CHEMICAL PROPERTIES

When Concentrate 50 is used as directed, it will kill *Chlorella pyrenoidosa* (green algae), *Phormidium inundatum*, *Phormidium retzii*, *Lyngba versicolor* (blue-green algae) and other visible swimming pool algae. NOTE: Kill, control and/or destroy refer to initial dose. Suppressing growth, or inhibiting growth of algae, refer to maintenance dose. Concentrate 50 does not contain any mercury or other heavy metals and will not harm pool equipment. Concentrate 50 is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals but should not be mixed with soap or other cleaners or premixes with other water treating chemicals. Concentrate 50 works best when added by itself directly to swimming pool water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Initial dose is used at the beginning of the swimming season when filling the pool. If the pool has visible algae growth, the initial dose should be repeated within 48 hours after the killed algae are removed from the pool. Maintenance dose should be added at least once every 7 days. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently. If makeup water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 6 fl. oz. of Concentrate 50 for each 10,000 gallons of fresh makeup water added per week. When swimming season is over, add 5 fl. oz. of Concentrate 50 to 10,000 gallons of water in treating water left in the pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

DANGER: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
