DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Coastal Winter-Chlor Long Lasting Chlorinating Tablets are to be used to help control, by disinfectant and algaestatic action, swim pool odors and algae during winter months. Each Tablet weighs 5-1/3 oz., and each 3-Tab Basket of Winter-Chlor Chlorinating Tablets treat up to 22,000 gallons of water. They are intended to slowly meter chlorine into pool water. In order to obtain its maximum effect, use as follows:

1. Remove all debris from pool by skimming surface, running filter and vacuuming foreign particles from bottom of pool.
2. Superchlorinate with Coastal Boost/Shock or Iso Chlor. Continue running filter pump. When the free chlorine residual reduces to 1-3 parts per million, add Coastal Winter Aid while walking around edge of the pool. Then remove the 3-Tab Basket(s) of Winter-Chlor Long Lasting Chlorinating Tablets from plastic bags, and drop basket(s) into water toward center of the pool.
3. Drain any water from filter and pool piping to prevent freezing. Disconnect filters, pipes, chlorinators, lights, etc.
4. Cover the pool with a Coastal Winter Pool Cover.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

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DANGER: Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance, contact the regional office of EPA.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT: Mix only with water. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not re-seal the container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well-ventilated area. Flood with large volume of water, if necessary.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID: If swallowed feed bread soaked in milk followed by olive oil or cooking oil. Call a physician immediately. If on skin, brush off excess chemical and flush skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention. If in eyes, flush with cold

water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in sealed container when not in use. Store in cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Do not reuse baskets or poly bag. Wrap container and put in trash.
