PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID: If swallowed, feed bread soaked in milk, followed by olive oil or cooking oi. Call a physician immediately. If on skin, brush off excess chemical and flush skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention. If in eyes, immediately flush with cold water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT: Mix only with water. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other products. Such use might cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with organic matter or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or

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decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area, or bury in a safe place.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Recommended for hot tubs and spas operating at temperatures 90-105F. Coastal Hot Tubs 'n Spas Long-Lasting Chlorinating $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. tablets are to be used as a disinfectant and algae control. Each disposable floating dispenser contains two $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. tablets intended to slowly meter chlorine into water.

START-UP: When starting up a reopened or freshly filled hot tub or spa, make sure that the filtration system is clean and operating properly. Using the Coastal Hot Tubs 'n Spas Pro Test Kit, check pH and total alkalinity of the water and adjust, if necessary, to within the chlorinate the water with Coastal Hot Tubs 'n Spas Stabilized Chlorinating Concentrate Granules while the circulating system is operating and the aeration shut off.

DAILY: Using the Hot Tubs 'n Spas Pro Test Kit as a daily guide, maintain the free chlorine residaul of the water at 1.0-2.0 ppm. When below 1ppm, add an additional floating dispenser of chlorinating tablets. For best results, maintain a pH of 7.2-7.6. If below 7.2, add Coastal pH Plus. If pH is above 7.6, add pH Minus. Superchlorinate hot tub and spa water periodically, depending on bather load, with Coastal Hot Tubs 'n Spas Stabilized Chlorinating Concentrate Granules.
