

DIRECTIONS FOR USE DAIRY PLANTS

Coastal Dairy Bactericide solutions containing 200 ppm available chlorine will sanitize all utensils and equipment. Prepare this solution by dissolving 5 1/4 oz. Coastal Dairy Bactericide per 100 gallons of water.

DAIRY UTENSILS: Clean utensils and then immerse in the dairy sanitizing solution containing 200 ppm available chlorine for at least 2 minutes. Remove, drain and rinse with fresh water.

PRESSURE METHOD FOR SANITIZING EQUIPMENT: Clean equipment. Rinse. Prepare a sufficient volume of Dairy Bactericide solution containing 200 ppm available chlorine to fill the equipment. Pump this sanitizing solution through the system until it is full and all air is excluded. Allow solution to remain in contact with all surfaces for at least 2 minutes. Then drain off the solution and flush equipment with fresh water.

SPRAY METHOD FOR SANITIZING EQUIPMENT: After equipment has been cleaned and rinsed. Add Dairy Bactericide solution containing 200 ppm available chlorine into a pressure sprayer or fogger. Apply spray heavily to all surfaces. Allow excess solution to drain off. Rinse with fresh water, and then place in service. Note: Be sure to also rinse sprayers immediately after use.

WATER SUPPLIES

MANUAL TREATMENT: Add 1 teaspoonful Dairy Bactericide per 450 gallons to provide water with approximately 1 ppm available chlorine. Stir water and allow it to stand for 20 minutes. Then test for chlorine residual. If residual is not at least 0.2 ppm, repeat procedure. Maintain at least 0.2 ppm at all times. Use the Coastal Test Kit Daily.

CONTINUOUS TREATMENT: Prepare a solution containing 2% available chlorine by dissolving 5 1/4 oz. Dairy Bactericide per gallon of water in a plastic container. Let the small amount of insolubles settle to the bottom of the plastic container. Decant off solution for continuous treatment using a hypochlorinator. See manufacturer's directions. Maintain a chlorine residual of 0.2 ppm.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not handle with bare hands. Use rubber gloves or clean, dry utensils when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust and fumes. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

DANGER: STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT. Mix only into water. Contamination may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible fire and explosion. Avoid any contact with flame or burning material such as a lighted cigarette. Do not contaminate with moisture, garbage, dirt, organic matter, chemicals or household products.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate lakes, ponds or streams by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Storage and Disposal

Keep product in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water before discarding. Place in trash collection, dispose in approved landfill area or bury in a safe place.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID: If on skin, brush off excess chemical and flush skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

If Inhaled: Remove person to fresh air. Get medical attention.

If in Eyes: Flush with cold water for at least 15 minutes. Get immediate medical attention.

If Swallowed: Give bread soaked in milk followed by large amount of water. Get immediate medical attention.
