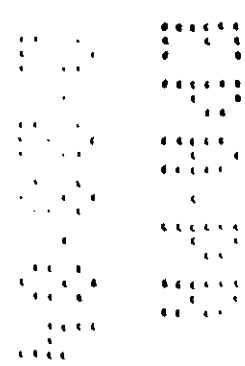

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Iso Clor II Big Tabs are to be used as a disinfectant and as an algae control in pool water. In order to receive its maximum effect, use as follows:

- 1) Adjust and maintain pH in the range of 7.2-7.6 with Coastal pH Plus or pH Minus as indicated by a Coastal Test Kit.
- 2) Superchlorinate with Boost Pool Shock Treatment to a level of 10 ppm. (parts per million), free available chlorine, in accordance with label directions. Do not re-enter pool until chlorine residual drops to 2.0 ppm.
- 3) Adjust cyanuric acid level to 3 ppm. (parts per million) with Coastal Chlorine Stabilizer following label directions.
- 4) Add one Iso Clor II Big Tab per 10,000 gals of pool water daily or as needed as determined by a Coastal Test Kit to maintain a 1-2 ppm chlorine residual. Do not throw tablets directly into pool as they may cause spotting or bleaching of liner. Iso Clor II Big Tabs should be added to a top water skimmer, floating dispenser or automatic chlorinator. Dosage may vary due to unusual conditions, such as heavy bather loads, wind, heavy rains and high temperatures. One tablet weighs approximately 5-1/3 oz.
