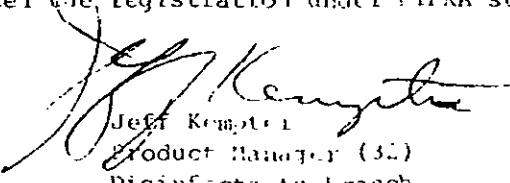


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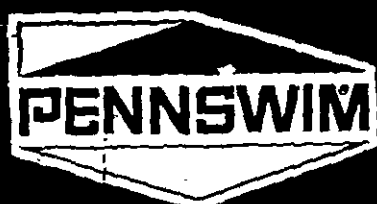

CONTINUING FLOW METHOD: Initial Dose - When system is noticeably fouled, apply 10 to 20 oz. of Sontary per 10,000 gal. of water in the system to obtain a 10 ppm available chlorine level.
Subsequent Dose - Maintain the treatment level by starting a continuous feed of 1 oz. of Sontary per 2,000 gal. of water lost by blowdown to maintain a 3 ppm chlorine residual. Daily fouled systems must be cleaned before treatment is begun.
