

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Big Shot should be used at start-up, once-a-week, or as necessary to eliminate discomforting irritations due to combined chloramines in the pool and to control algae.

Prior to using Big Shot, adjust the pH of the pool water using Coastal pH Plus or pH Minus in accordance with label directions. Maintain the pH in the range of 7.2-7.8. Add 1.5 oz. of Big Shot per 1,000 gallons of pool water to yield available chlorine residual of 5-10 ppm. Big Shot should be sprinkled over an extensive area of pool water surface, added through a skimmer, or pre-dissolved with the dissolved solution poured over a wide area of the pool surface. Allow the chlorine residual to drop to 1-3 ppm. Prior to re-entering the pool. If algae growth is present, brush affected areas with a stiff bristle broom. For winterizing use, add 0.5 oz. of Big Shot per 1,000 gallons of pool water, while pool is still clean and clear. Run filter for at least 2 hours. Follow manufacturer's closing instructions.
