- In the Precautionary Statement of your draft label, revise the "If Swallowed" sentence to read: "If swallowed, promptly drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.".

The revised, updated Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), submitted with the amendment package discussed above, agrees with the product label and is acceptable.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add an initial dose of 13 to 24 fl. oz. of Coastal Non-Foaming 30% Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. Pools containing just visible algae growth, should receive an initial dose of 24 to 36 fl. oz. of Coastal Non-Foaming 30% Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. After 24 hours, vacuum pool to remove algae debris. On a regular basis, (every 5 to 7 days), use a maintenance dose of 4 to 9 fl. oz. of Non-Foaming 30% Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. During hot, sunny weather, more frequent additions may be necessary.

Coastal's Non-Foaming 30% Algaecide will prevent the growth of most algae during the off season, when the pool is not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 13 to 21 fl. oz. of Coastal Non-Foaming 30% Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. For best results, circulate the pool water, prior to covering the pool for the winter.
