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

DANGER POISON



Poisonous by Skin Contact, Inhalation, or Swallowing. Rapidly absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe spray mist.

SE ONLY WHEN WEARING THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING.

(1) Wear waterproof pants, coat, hat, rubber boots, or rubber overshoes. (2) Wear safety goggles. (4) Wear heavy duty, natural rubber gloves.

WORK SAFETY RULES

Keep all unprotected persons and children away from treated area or where there is danger of drift.

Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. If you feel sick in any way, STOP work and get help right away.

IMPORTANTI Before removing gloves, wash them in soap and water. Always wash hands, face and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating or drinking.

AFTER WORK, take off all work clothes and shoes. Shower, using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes when leaving job. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. POISON SIGNS (Symptoms)

EPN Methyl Parathion is a very dangerous poison. It rapidly enters the body on contact with all ski a surfaces and eyes. Clothing wet with this material must be removed immediately. Exposed persons must exceive prompt medical treatment or they may die.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to EPN Methyl Parathion and describe his condition. IF BREATHING HAS STOPPED, start artificial respiration immediately and maintain until doctor sees victim. If Swallowed - Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger or blunt object. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention. IN CASE OF CONTACT, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and above. See doctor immediately.

NOTE TO PHY ... AN: TREAT SYMPTOMATICALLY

Antidote — administer atropine suifate in large doses, TWO to FOUR mg, intravenously or intramuscularly as soon as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat at 5 to 10 minute intervals until signs of atropinisation appear, 2 - PAM chloride is 1 les antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. DO NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS. EPN Methyl Parathion is a strong cholinesternse inhibitor affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and producing cardiac and respiratory depression. Methyl Parathion for use on cotton insects. It is suitable for use in conventional hydraulic aprayers and sirplane sprayers. For aerial application dilute in 1 to 3 gallons of water per acre.

COTTON: For control of thrips, certain spider mites, cotton fleahoppers, boll weevils, bollworm, yellow striped armyworm, garden webworn, and Mexican bean beetle, apply when insects appear and wepeat at 5 day intervals as necessary.
