DIRECTIONS

Use material as it comes from can. Do not thin for dipping or spraying. Sleepers, joints, jambs, window frames, other mill work and timber should be treated before installation for best results. At least two flowing coats should be used on timbers which are to come in contact with the ground or masonry.

FOR BRUSH: Apply liberally using as many coats as necessary to secure penetration desired. Protection is dependent on good penetration. At least two flowing coats should be used on timbers which are to come in contact with the ground or masonry. Timbers and other heavy wood members should be free of bark, dry and well-seasoned and be immersed for 12 to 48 hours when treated by the dip method.

Creosote Oil is especially effective as a Wood Preservative in protecting wood against fungus growths which cause wood rot and stain, Termites and Powder Post Beetles.
