Subject: Amendment - Changing Petroleum Distillate to an inert  
SK-SUREKILL BRAND Pyrethrin Plus Spray Insecticide with  
VAPONA  
EPA Registration No. 4866-3  
Your Application Dated November 7, 1989

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. The words **ACTIVE INGREDIENT(S)** and **INERT INGREDIENT(S)** must be printed in type of the same size and be given equal prominence. The words **ACTIVE INGREDIENT(S)** and **INERT INGREDIENT(S)** must be aligned to the same margin.
2. Add a footnote to the label ingredient statement indicating: **Contains petroleum distillates.**
3. Revise "**Do not use in food...**" and add these precautions to the Directions for Use:

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation.

4. Make the following revise under Environmental Hazards:  
**Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.**

5. Add the following note to physician to the Statement of Practical Treatment Statement:

Note to Physician - Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated in material was taken internally. DDVP (Vapona) is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

6. In the last paragraph under Space Spray directions, add the following precautions: "Remove animals prior to treatment."
7. Under Precautionary Statements add:

Wear NIOSH or MSHA approved respiration when applying indoors as a space spray or fog.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
