Dear Mr. Binter:

The following amendments, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with conditions.

Conditions:

- 1. Separate "It is violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" statement from the directions for use.
- 2. Revise the direction of use to state that you must pre-clean surface before sanitizing. The pre-cleaning directions for use must precede the actual use directions on the label.
- 3. Put spaces between the words "Have the product..." under First Aid statement.
- 4. Revise the Ingredient statement as follows:

Regulatory Management Branch II Antimicrobials Division (7510P) Indco PF-13 Sanitizer is recommended for use on hard (non-porous) surfaces or on dishes, glasses, or food processing equipment or utensils, including dairy and brewery equipment and utensils.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Purchaser must be able to use Chlorine Test Kit to make sure available chlorine level does not fall below50 ppm or above 100 ppm. Prepare a sanitizing solution by dissolving 1 oz. of Indoo PF-13 Sanitizer per 10 gallons of water. This gives a solution containing 100 ppm available chlorine. Clean and rinse item or surface prior to sanitizing. Then place dishes, glasses, equipment or utensils in the solution or spread it over the surface to be sanitized. Let stand 2-5 minutes. The same solution should be used in the feedtank in immersion or spray type machines providing 2-5 minutes contact time for sanitizing dishes, glasses, food processing, equipment and utensils. Clean and rinseitems prior to sanitizing. The items are then ready for use. The sanitizing solution should be used promptly after mixing.

CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Danger: Strong oxidizing agent. Use only dean, dry utensils. Contamination with moisture, organic matter or other chemicals (including pool chemicals) or any other foreign matter may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases and possible generation of fire explosion. Avoid any contact with flaming or burning material, such as a lighted digarette. Indico PF-13 decomposes at 460 °-500 ° F with liberation of heat and harmful gases. Do not use Indico PF-13 in any chlorinating device which has been used with any inorganic or unstabilized chlorinating compounds (e.g. calcium hypochlorite). Such use may cause fire or explosion.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in tightly closed containers when not in use. Store in a cool dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pestidde wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pestidde, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pestidde or Environmental Control Agency, or the hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. Do not reuse empty container. Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen dinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. Dispose of drum in the same manner.

EMERGENCY HANDLING

In case of contamination or decomposition of product, do not reseal container. If possible, isolate container in open and well-ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water. Dispose of contaminated material in an approved landfill area.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

Danger: Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on dothing. Do not handle with bare hands. Wear goggles or face shield, use rubber gloves, and use only thoroughly dean, dry utensils when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust and fumes. Remove and wash contaminated dothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms.
