DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling.

For Egg Wash: Dissolve one or two ounces of Indco PF-14 Wash Sanitizer in ten gallons of warm (125 F) water to provide 200 ppm of available chlorine respectively. For a basket of eggs in the 200 ppm available chlorine solution, immerse for two or three minutes, remove and dry. For spray-type equipment, spray with the 100 ppm available chlorine solution. For dishes, glasses, food processing equipment, one or two ounces of Indco PF-14 Wash Sanitizer in ten gallons of warm (125 F) water provides 100 to 200 ppm of available chlorine. Clean and rinse items prior to being sanitized in solution and hold for 15 minutes. Rinse with potable water and dry. The sanitized tank for immersion or spray-type equipment should be used for 15 minutes contact time for sanitizing dishes, glasses, equipment and utensils. Rinse well with potable water. Items are then ready for use.

The sanitizing solutions should be used as directed. The solution is allowed to stand or is reused. Chlorine has not been maintained, additional sanitizer should be added to maintain a minimum of 100 ppm available chlorine.

FDA requires food contact surfaces to be sanitized and to be allowed to air dry. No potable water should be used for rinsing.

Indco PF-14 Wash Sanitizer is also recommended for use in sanitizing dishes, glasses, food processing equipment and utensils including dairy and brewery equipment and utensils.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
For Egg Wash: Dissolve one or two ounces of Indco PF-14 Wash Sanitizer in ten gallons of warm (125 F) water. This provides 100 or 200 ppm of available chlorine respectively. For immersion treatment dip a basket of eggs in the 200 ppm available chlorine solution, hold for two or three minutes, remove and dry. With a conveyor type machine spray with the 100 ppm available chlorine solution and allow eggs to drain and dry. Eggs may be rinsed with potable water if desired.
For dishes, glasses, food processing equipment and utensils: Dissolve one or two ounces of Indco PF-14 Wash Sanitizer per ten gallons of warm (125 F) water. This provides 100 to 200 ppm of available chlorine respectively. Clean and rinse items prior to sanitizing. Then dip the items to be sanitized in solution and hold for two or three minutes. Remove with potable water and dry. The same solution may be used in the food tank for immersion or spray type machines providing two to five minutes contact for sanitizing dishes, glasses and food processing equipment and utensils. Rinse well with potable water and dry. The items are then ready for use.
The sanitizing solution should be used promptly after mixing and if the solution is left standing, the color and tests show the level of available chlorine has decreased. Indco PF-14 Wash Sanitizer is available in a concentration of 100 ppm available chlorine.
For sanitizing of food processing equipment, use 200 ppm chlorine solution with a spray type machine.
