**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

In violation of federal law to use this product with its labeling.  
Dissolve 1 1/2 oz. Indco PF-15 Wash and Surface Sanitizer in 1 gallon of water to give a solution of 1:100 strength. After cleaning to remove gross dirt, apply the sanitizing solution to the surface and let stand 2-5 minutes. Rinse well with water. The surface is then ready for use. The same solution may be used in the spray type machines providing 2-5 minute dwell time. Food processing equipment and systems prior to sanitizing. After sanitizing, rinse with water and dry. They are then ready for use. The sanitizing solution should be used if the solution is allowed to stand or is reused. If the solution has not been maintained add Surface Sanitizer should be added to the available chlorine.

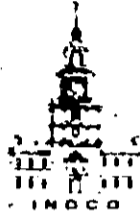

Dissolve 10 g Indco PF-15 Wash and Surface Sanitizer per 10 liters of water to obtain a solution containing 100 ppm available chlorine. After cleaning to remove gross dirt and heavy soil from surfaces, apply the sanitizing solution to the surface to be sanitized and let stand 5 minutes. Rinse well with clean water and dry. The material is then ready for use.  
This material may be used in the food industry in immersion or spray applications providing a minimum contact time for sanitizing food processing equipment and utensils. Clean and rinse thoroughly before use. After sanitizing, the surface well with clean water and dry. They are then ready for use.  
For sanitizing of equipment, after making up the solution as above, immerse the equipment and let stand for 5 minutes. Rinse the equipment thoroughly with clean water. Indco PF-15 Wash and Surface Sanitizer is not intended for use in the sanitizing of mammals at all times.
