Roach Powder is a free-flowing and non-volatile. The powder is an insect, causing intimate contact.

Roach Powder is designed for use in buildings, hotels, apartment buildings, industrial plants, hospitals and other areas susceptible to cockroaches. When treating an area, a bulb type hand duster is recommended. The powder should be dusted liberally into the soffit and sub-cabinet voids, under showers, tubs and around drain and water pipe joints.

When applied during construction or hand operated duster in buildings, into all hidden areas. To treat a structure, simply bore a 1/4 inch void and insert duster nozzle in inconspicuous place, there with close the aperture after dusting.

For the average home of apartment will suffice for long-term protection. Larger structures use proper quantities of powder.

Roach Powder provides long lasting protection. Should the roach population increase at a future date, simply reapply as described in the above directions. In any circumstances, an annual application is recommended.

NOTICE

Roach Powder is capable of killing roaches and therefore should not be applied into areas underlain with vegetation.
