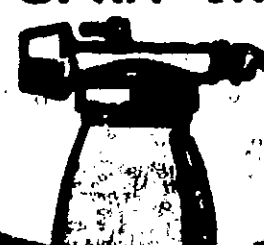

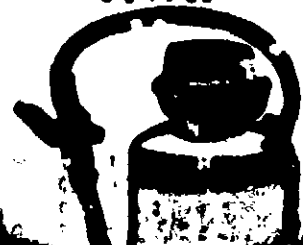

PILL KILL WEED KILLER

FOR DANDELIONS AND BROADLEAF WEEDS
(contains low volatile 2,4-D and Silvex)

One pill makes 2 gallons of weed killing mixture. Contents of this package makes 24 gallons of weed killer covering up to 5,000 square feet.

3 WAYS TO USE PILL KILL

Hose End Sprayer

Use 1 pill for each 2 gallon mark on sprayer jar (most are calibrated in 2 gallon multiples). For example, to make 10 gallons of concentrate, drop 5 pills into jar — add water to 10 gallon mark. Shake gently to dissolve. Never use more than 5 pills (10 gallons) in hose end sprayer at one time.

Pressure Tank Sprayer

Check gallon capacity of your tank sprayer. Drop in 1 pill for each 2 gallons. Fill with water to proper level and replace cover. Pill dissolves as pressure is pumped up.

Watering Can

Check gallon capacity of watering can. (most cans are of 2 gallon size). Drop in 1 pill and add water to proper level. Pill dissolves quickly.

Kill these weeds at

Sheep Sorrel	Purslane
Ground Ivy	

Repeated applications
for stubborn weeds at 2
pills per 2 gallons:

Oxalis	Henbit
Speedwell	Wild Onion
Poison Ivy	Poison Oak
Yarrow	

DIRECTIONS

Apply on lawns where dandelions, chickweed, clover and other susceptible broadleaf weeds are actively growing.

1. One pill makes 2 gallons of weed killing mixture.
2. Drop pill (or pills) into container—then, add water.
3. Make sure pills are dissolved before using.
4. Do not use during or before rain.
5. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.
6. Rinse dispenser thoroughly before and after each use.
7. Weeds are killed by slow chemical reaction. Complete kill requires 10 days to 2 weeks.
