TOBACCO PLANT BEDS: For the control of aphids and flea beetles, apply 1 ounce per 100 square feet of bed. This container will treat 1000 square

feet of plant bed. Apply evenly over bed area, just before seeding. Work the granules into the top 2 or 3 inches of soil and seed beds in normal manner. An alternative treatment may be made by broadcasting the granules evenly over

the plants after emergence and watering thoroughly. Do not apply more than once per season.

### DANGER


