


TRIPLE ACTION VEGETABLE DUST DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DUST: Apply thoroughly to vegetables and flowering plants, making sure to treat both top and bottom sides of leaves, stems and fruit. Make first application when insects first appear and / or disease is anticipated. Begin early, when new growth is starting. Repeat as necessary, generally at 7 day intervals.

BEANS: (Snap and Lima)—Controls leafhoppers, Mexican bean beetles, bean leaf veetles and thrips. Diseases: downy mildew, bean rust, and anthracnose. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, BROCCOLI, TURNIPS AND CARROTS—Controls imported cabbage worn, cabbage looper, flea beetles. Diseases: downy mildew and alternaria leaf spot. Stop use 14 days before harvest on Broccoli, 7 days on Cabbage and Cauliflower, 7 days on Turnips and Carrots, or 14 days if tops are to be used for feed or food.

MELONS, CUCUMBERS AND SQUASH—Controls melon worms, striped and spotted cucumber beetles and flea beetles. Diseases: downy mildew, alternaria (Macrosporium blight), anthracnose and gummy stem blight. Stop use 7 days before harvest.

TOMATOES AND EGGPLANT-Controls tomato horn worm, tomato fruit worm, flea beetles, leafhoppers. Diseases include early and late blight, anthracnose, stemphylium and septoria leaf spots and cladosporium gray mold. Stop use 7 days before harvest.

FLOWERS AND ORNAMENTALS (On roses, mums, snapdragons, glads, hollyhocks) —Controls bottotic blight and stemphylium on glads rust septorialleaf spot and ammuchose on snaps, mums, carnations and hollyhocks. Black spot on roses. Kills thrips, grasshoppers and cutworms. For cutworms, dust the soil around the base of each plant.

NOTE FOR PHYSICIAN Carbaryl is a moderate, reversible, cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal, KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND ANIMALS.

CAUTION: HARMFUL IF INHALED OR SWALLOWED. Do not breather dust. Do not take internally. Avoid contact. Wash hands before eating.
