GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS

Keep trees vigorous and free from injuries to trunk. Avoid excessive grading or filling over roots. Promptly remove dead or infested trees to help prevent spreading of infestation to healthy trees. Spray removed trees as directed below. Spray all adjacent trees to prevent investment.

SOUTHERN PINE BEETLE

Dilute 2½ oz. Concentrate with 1 gallon of water (1 part to 55 parts water) and spray entire trunk of tree with a medium spray to point of run-off. Use enough spray pressure to penetrate cracks in bark of tree. Repeat application in 30 to 60 days.

BLACK TURPENTINE BEETLE

Dilute 9 oz. Concentrate with 1 gallon of water (1 part to 15 parts water) and spray lower 10 ft. of tree, exposed roots, and fresh stumps with a medium spray to point of run-off. Use enough pressure to penetrate cracks in bark of trees. Do not apply to wet bark. Repeat as needed.

NOTE: This dilution will cause burning of grass and shrubbery. If spray comes in contact with these areas, wash thoroughly with clear water.
